Eligible entrants:	Entry is only open to residents of ACT, QLD, SA, VIC and WA. Entrants under the age of 18 must have parent or legal guardian approval to enter.

Both the Nominee and Nominator must be a resident of the same State/Territory.
Entries permitted:	Only one (1) eligible entry per person will be accepted. The entrant is eligible to win a maximum of one (1) prize. By completing the entry method, the entrant will receive one (1) entry.
Winner notification:	The winners will be contacted via telephone and/or email within two (2) days of the judging.
Unclaimed Prizes:	In the event of an unclaimed prize, the Promoter may at its discretion assign the prize to the entry judged the next best entry, conduct a further judging to award the prize, or withdraw the prize unawarded. The Promoter is under no obligation to award any unclaimed prize.

1. The entrant agrees and acknowledges that they have read these Conditions of Entry (and Schedule) and that entry into the Promotion is deemed to be acceptance of these Conditions of Entry (and Schedule). Any capitalised terms used in these Conditions of Entry have the meaning given in the Schedule, unless stated otherwise.
2. The Promotion commences on the Start Date and ends on the End Date ("Promotional Period"). Entries are deemed to be received at the time of receipt by the Promoter and not at the time of transmission or deposit by the entrant. Records of the Promoter and its agencies are final and conclusive as to the time of receipt.
3. Valid and eligible entries will be accepted during the Promotional Period.
4. Employees (and the immediate family members) of agencies/companies directly associated with the conduct of this Promotion, the Promoter, its distributors, suppliers, subsidiary companies/businesses and associated companies and agencies are not eligible to enter. "Immediate family member" means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
5. If a prize is won by a person under the age of 18, the prize may be awarded to the winner's parent or guardian and where applicable to the prize a nominated parent/guardian must accompany any person under 18 years of age.
6. Judging:
 - a) The winners will be determined by representatives of the Promoter. Each entry will be judged on the basis of the individual originality, creative merit and literary merit of 50-word or less response provided on entry.
 - i) **Major Prize:** The best entry overall, as determined by the judges, will win a visit from Specsavers cricket ambassador and Australian cricket legend, Ian Healy for a skills day at the Major Prize winner's local club, along with a Cricket Australia memorabilia pack (for themselves and up to 12 members of the winner's local cricket team). For the sake of clarity, the Major Prize winner will be the cricket volunteer nominated in the Major Prize winning entry.

The Promoter will determine the exact date and time on which the visit portion of the prize will take place, and will be dependent on Ian Healy's availability.

- ii) **State Prizes (5 total – 1 per State - ACT, QLD, SA, VIC and WA):** The best valid entry from each State (ACT, QLD, SA, VIC and WA) will win thirteen (13) tickets to a Gillette One Day International match in their State (as specified below). Tickets will be awarded to both the Nominator and Nominee from the winning entry and up to ten (10) people from the Nominee's local club. For the sake of clarity, the Major Prize winner will also be deemed the State winner for the State in which the Nominator is located.

- iii) The judges may select additional reserve entries which they determine to be the next best, and record them in order, in case of an invalid entry or ineligible entrant.
- iv) The winners will be determined by skill. Chance plays no part in determining the winners. The judges' decision is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.
7. No part of a prize is exchangeable, redeemable for cash or any other prize or transferable.
 8. If a winner is unwilling or unable to attend at the designated time for a match event from those specified below, they forfeit the prize and the Promoter is not obliged to substitute the prize.

The Promoter and event organisers hereby expressly reserve the right to eject any winner and/or his/her companions for any inappropriate behaviour, including but not limited to intoxication, whilst participating in any element of the prize.

If for any reason any aspect of this Promotion is not capable of running as planned, including by reason of computer virus, communications network failure, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure or any cause beyond the control of the Promoter, the Promoter may in its sole discretion cancel, terminate, modify suspend the Promotion and invalidate any affected entries, or suspend or modify a prize.
22. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to validate and check the authenticity of entries and entrant's details (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence). In the event that a winner cannot provide suitable proof as required by the Promoter to validate their entry, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered. Incomplete, indecipherable, inaudible, incorrect and illegible entries, as applicable, will at the Promoter's discretion be deemed invalid and not eligible to win. In the event that there is a dispute concerning the conduct of the Promotion, the decision of the Promoter is final and binding on each entrant and no correspondence will be entered into.

Australian Cricket may disclose your personal information to other parties, including Australian Cricket's third party service providers. From time to time, these third parties may be located (and so your personal information may be disclosed) overseas, including in India, the USA and the UK, and other countries from time to time. Australian Cricket may use and disclose your personal information for direct marketing purposes, unless you opt out (which you can do at any time in accordance with Australian Cricket's Privacy Policy), and for facilitating further offers directly from third parties if you opt in to receive those offers. You can request to access, update or correct any personal information Australian Cricket holds about you by writing to Cricket Australia's Privacy Officer at 60 Jolimont Street, Jolimont, VIC, 3002 or sending an email to privacy@cricket.com.au.
29. Cricket Australia reserves the right in its absolute discretion to change or amend the International Cricket/KFC T20 Big Bash League fixture without notice. Neither the Promoter nor Cricket Australia accept responsibility for the cancellation or delay of any cricket match connected with this Promotion for any reason beyond the control of the Promoter or Cricket Australia.
30. By entering this promotion entrants agree to comply, and ensure that each subsequent ticket holder complies, with the ticket conditions which accompany any tickets won in conjunction with the promotion. Entrants also agree to comply, and ensure that each subsequent ticket holder complies, with Cricket Australia's Ticket and Entry Conditions (available at

www.cricket.com.au/tickets) supplemented by conditions of entry imposed by the venue operator. The Promoter will provide every person attending the match as part of the promotion with a copy of Cricket Australia's Ticket and Entry Conditions with delivery of the prize tickets.
